

How Nook Lane works with external agencies

Learning Support – to assess a child's processing skills, sequential memory, phonic skills, maths skills, assessing for a possible dyslexic profile.

Speech & Language Team support understanding of a child's receptive and expressive language skills, social communication differences and stuttering and stammering difficulties

Autism team – support school/families through informal consultation meetings, observations and sign posting for further support in the area.

Educational Psychology service – support school/families through informal consultations, guidance for staff about interventions, formal assessments for learning and social/emotional needs.

Multi Agency Support Team (MAST) – supporting children/families with emotional health and well-being, low mood, anxiety, low self-esteem, bereavement, attachment and parenting programmes.

Ryegate Children's centre – including the neuro-disability team who assess children with profiles of Attention Deficit, Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), dyspraxia, autism and other neurological differences.

Child & Adolescent mental health Service – CAMHS – supporting children with mental health difficulties which includes assessments, individual and family therapy.

VI and HI services - the school also works closely with the Visually Impaired and Hearing Impaired teams who support children in school.
