



Nook Lane Junior School Ofsted Report 2019

As you will be aware, Nook Lane Junior School was inspected on Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th March. The inspection was conducted by Robert Jones (Lead Inspector) and Dawn Foster (Ofsted Inspector). I am pleased to inform you that the inspection report is now available and it is attached for your attention. In the next few days the report will be published on the Ofsted website.

There were no shocks or surprises during the inspection or in the subsequent report which accurately summarises the key strengths of the school and clearly highlights what we can do to improve further. The overall judgement of “Good” matches the school’s evaluation of its performance against the Ofsted Framework. We are particularly pleased that the great work that staff do at Nook Lane to enhance children’s personal development and welfare has been acknowledged as “outstanding” and “exceptional”. During the verbal feedback to the senior leadership team and governors, the Lead Inspector said that this area of the school’s work should be shared nationally. Also pleasing, is the fact that our rich and broad curriculum was highlighted as a significant strength. Looking forward, we aim to maintain our successes, to continue to work on achieving higher outcomes across the curriculum for our more able pupils, particularly in maths, and to further improve children’s spelling.

The inspectors described the opportunity to spend two days at Nook Lane Junior School as, “a privilege” and they both asked me to pass on their gratitude to staff, governors, parents and carers and most importantly, the children.
