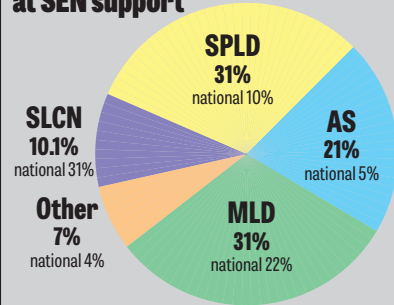

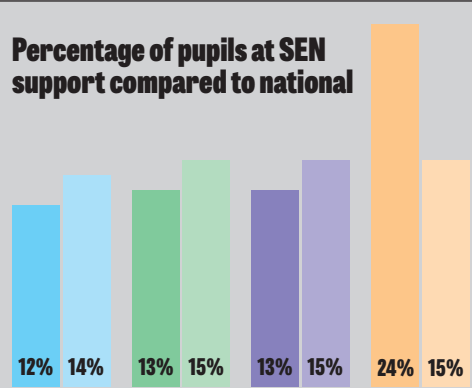
88% of Y3s made over 20 months progress

33% of Y4s made over 16 months progress

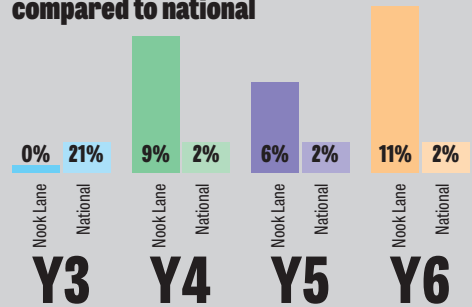
85% of Y5s made over 13 months progress

## PRIORITIES

- Using a new assessment system to monitor and track progress of students with SEND
- Spelling - provide a broad range of opportunities for children to develop successful strategies including access to phonics groups
- Increase the percentage of students with SEND achieving the expected standard in reading and maths (compared to national)

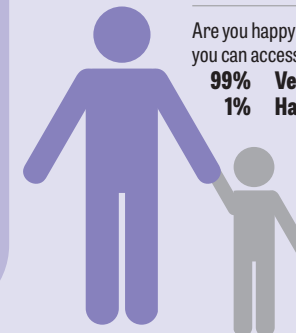
